Acts Thirtyfourth Legislature, Ch. 36, Sec. 5.Inasmuch as the law prescribes that public high schools shall be classified by the State Department of Education, all public schools of the State attempting to do high school work are required to make a report to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction as to course of study, teachers employed, number of years work, length of annual session, finance and equipment; and furnish specimens of written work of pupils, as a basis for classification. No school will be classified as a high school of the first class or of the second class until inspected and approved by a representative of the State Department of Education. By classification is meant: establishing educational standards;...
