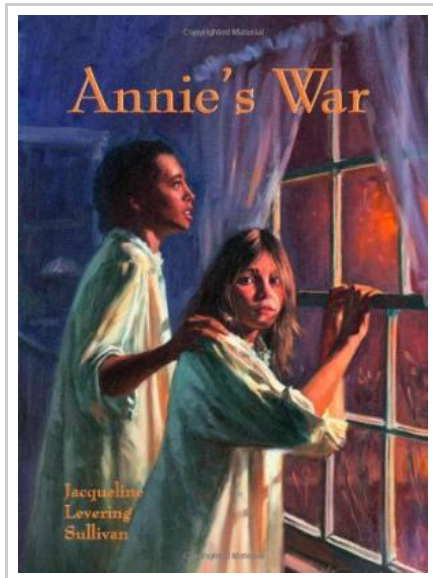




Annie's War
